

**City of Hill City
Public Hearing
April 12, 2016**

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Public Hearing was held in the Community Room at City Hall in regard to Ordinance 129 – adopting a schedule of fees and charges for various services, licenses and permits. Members present: Mayor Larry Baker, Council members Audrey Baratto, Tina Haugen, Dave Lange and Nate Rollins. Mayor Baker called the meeting to order at 5:34 p.m.

The following are the changes to Ordinance 129:

- Adding Pound Fees under the Code Enforcement: \$40.00 Pick-up Fee, \$25.00 Per Day at pound, plus the fine.
- Under code enforcement change the wording from burning of solid fuels to non-permit able items.
- Camping fees change to \$30.00 Full Hook-up Sites (water, sewer & electric), \$25.00 Partial Hook-up Site (water & electric), and Tents \$20.00.
- Canoe's, Kayak's and Paddleboards will be at the current rate.
- Under Licensing/permitting take out the reissuance of an Expired Permit.
- No changes to water and sewer rates as they want more information.

Motion made by Rollins to approve all the above mentions changes to Ordinance 129, second by Baratto. Motion carried with all members present voting in favor.

Motion made by Rollins to adjourn the Public Hearing at 6:04 pm, second by Lange. Motion carried with all members present voting in favor.
